HOMEWORK FOR BOARD PRESIDENTS: Onboarding to Build Successful School Boards NYSSBA'S President Gavel Podcast is available on the NYSSBA website. An effective onboarding process benefits new members by helping them acclimate quickly while avoiding common pitfalls. Please keep in mind that you may have new School Board members who do not complete their Mandated Governance Training or Fiscal Oversight Responsibility Training prior to the first meeting. In some cases, you may have Board Members who may not complete their training until the end of their first year. The podcast provides helpful advice for designing an On Boarding process. The On Boarding process is not the same as an orientation. The host of the podcast is Jamie McPherson, Deputy Director of Leadership Development for NYSSBA and guest Mark Snyder, Senior Leadership Development

Manager of NYSSBA and a former School Board Member.

RURAL SCHOOLS ASSOCIATION OF NEW YORK STATE: Clarifies position on Regional High Schools. RSA is not seeking regional high schools for all small and rural districts. Regional High Schools are just an option that schools may utilize to address the needs of children with less funding from New York State. RSA emphasizes Regional High Schools should be an option - not a mandate for schools in New York state.
