David DiPietro was elected to the New York State Assembly November 6, 2012. He was raised in the East Aurora area and attended Immaculate Conception School and East Aurora UFSD. He possesses a Bachelors Degree in Business Administration from Wittenberg University.

Assemblyman DiPietro won the seat for the 147th Assembly District on November 6, 2012 under the platform of cutting taxes, reducing the size and cost of government and protecting funding for agriculture.

David served as a trustee and the Mayor of the Village of East Aurora prior to running for the Assembly. He was recognized at the State of the County of Erie Conference as a leader in New York State for merg-



es and consolidations among government services and departments. As Mayor, he cut taxes 3 consecutive years.

Mr. DiPietro also has experience in small business. Several years ago he took over the family dry cleaning business, Sparkle Cleaners of Amherst. Under his leadership within three years, he tripled sales, doubled employees, added two locations, and added many corporate accounts and routes. Prior to that, he worked at M & T Bank in Buffalo in the Trust Division as a computer/accounting consultant to small businesses.

While serving as an Assemblyman, David introduced legislation to repeal the NY SAFE ACT. His voting is conservative in nature and he voted against medical marijuana legislation. In 2019, he was sponsor of Bill A05498 to divide the state into 3 autonomous regions.

David is active in the East Aurora community where he resides with his wife Theresa and his 3 children, Daniel, Ryan and Ava Elizabeth.

Assemblyman DiPietro is an active member of the East Aurora Wesleyan Church, the East Aurora Moose Lodge #37, the American Legion Post 362, the East Aurora Rotary Club, Six Towns Youth Court and the East Aurora Boys and Girls Club.
