ECASB PROSPECTIVE SCHOOL BOARDS WORKSHOP: If you know of an individual that is interested in running for the school board, we would encourage you to urge them to attend a Prospective School Board Member workshop so that they are aware of the requirements and the work that is involved. Over the years, I have seen people run for the Board only to realize after they are elected, it is not what they imagined, or they are unable to make the time commitment or the commitment to advocate with elected officials. Many times when they decide to run for the Board, they are not even aware that they have to complete 6 hours of Governance Training and 6 hours of Fiscal Oversight Responsibility Training. ECASB has sent a flyer about the Prospective School Board member workshop to each school district that Boards of Education can share on their website. The information can be shared during the meeting, or post posters in the hallway of the building where they would pick up petitions. We have also sent press releases about the training sessions to local newspapers and radio stations.

<u>ECASB AWARDS COMMITTEE</u>: Has rescheduled their meeting. Once we know who the recipients of each of the awards are for 2025, we will begin sending out names of the recipients. This year some of the award recipients will be honored at the Annual Dinner in June, while other award categories will be recognized at the Back to School Dinner in August.

When I became NYSSBA Area 1 Director, I had as one of my goals to attend each of those schools. Last year I was able to make it to 6 schools. This week I started venturing out to the remaining schools. I attended Roy-Harts Board of Education meeting on Wednesday night and Attica CSD on Thursday night. I am able to see many familiar faces as many of the School Board Members from these districts have attended their Governance and Fiscal Oversight Trainings through us. Just a reminder - when you attend the trainings, you need to submit your completed certificates to the District Clerk for verification.

#### **NYSSBA AREA 1 DIRECTOR NEWS AND NOTES:**

Every two years, the Area 1 Director must run again. I hope to have school districts nominate me again this year and vote for me for the NYSSBA Area 1 Director for a second term. The new term will run from January 1, 2026 - December 31, 2027. A call for nominations usually goes out in April or early May. Individuals need a minimum of 5 nominations from member districts. Nominations only need to consist of a sentence on district letterhead stating the select school board has made the nomination for the candidate for a two year term for Area 1 effective January 1, 2026. Nominations must be turned in no later than 5:00 p.m. July 31st to Mary Metheny.

There are many deadline dates fast approaching for the Annual Convention and Expo regarding student performance groups, presentations and submission of artwork for the student art exhibit.
