NYSSBA MICROLEARNING CLASSES: NYSSBA's Micro Learning classes are classes that can be taken whenever and wherever it is convenient. They take 1-2 hours to complete. NEW BILL ALERT: The Legislature wants students on school boards. If Governor Kathy Hochul signs a newly passed bill, every school district and BOCES Board in the state will be required to have at least one ex-officio student representative. It could become effective as soon as July 1st, but is more likely to take effect for the 2025-2026 school year. Although not opposed to having a student representative, there was already a process in place to allow districts to have a representative. Personally, I have mixed emotions on this bill and the lack of transparency in the process and the procedure. Students would not be empowered to vote or attend executive sessions. They would not be able to attend any meeting or hearing that is not open to the public. My concern is that when a district has a controversial issue and the community is attending school board meetings in large numbers and commenting on social media, how will this affect the social well being of the student, even though they may not have been an integral part of the decision making process. Many of our adult members do not handle the stress well. What process will we have in place to address issues the student member of the board may be facing when they are "attacked"? If the bill becomes law - we once again have another law with very little information or direction.
