<u>BEST PRACTICES</u>: Last evening, the Gowanda CSD received a brief report on the hiring practices of the district. The report outlined the procedures and practices that the district follows for different

categories of employees within the district. It was a great reminder particularly for newer Board Members to remember that the Board only hires one employee - the Superintendent. All other employees of the district work for the Superintendent. There are different practices that are followed if an employee is a civil service employee, whether they are a certificated or non-certificated employee, and if the employee is an administrator. All positions would require background checks, interviews, etc, however, some positions have additional layers in the hiring process.

NYSSBA AREA 1 DIRECTOR NEWS AND NOTES:

In Erie County, I have yet to visit Williamsville CSD and Orchard Park CSD. This past week I was able to get to Attica CSD and Roy Hart CSD in Area 1. During the next few months I hope to get to the rest of the ECASB districts as well as a few more Area 1 Districts.

Schools should continue to contact their legislators with concerns during the budget negotiations process. Although there are many unknowns at the state and federal level, legislators need to be made aware that this does affect the most local level of government.
